

## Health Center shows off new facilities

That was the assessment of State Sen. Kate Sullivan and other speakers at an open house for the Health Center's new patient care addition Sunday, June 27.

The hospital unveiled the 12 new patient rooms in its new addition to more than 250 people who attended the open house.
