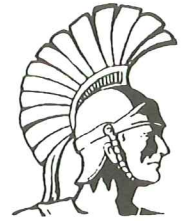

My name is Ginger Meyer. I am the Superintendent for Scribner-Snyder Community Schools. I'd like to offer my recommendation for Beckenhauer Construction. In the Fall of 2011, the School District conducted interviews with 3 highly qualified firms. The process included interviews and reference checking.
